

TRADE PARTNER PREQUALIFICATION DOCUMENT CHECKLIST

THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS MUST BE UPLOADED FOR A COMPLETE PREQUALIFICATION:

- OSHA 300 & 300A Logs (Past three years)
- Letter from Surety Company of Bondability

 This letter is commonly called a "Good-Guy Letter" and must be on your carrier's letterhead (dated within the current calendar year). Include a copy of your bonding status and capability, total bonding capacity and single/per project bond capacity.
- Current (unexpired) Certificate of Insurance and General Liability, Additional Insured endorsement forms CG 2010 0704 and CG 2037 0704 that meet Boldt's standard requirements
- ContractorScore Certificate

This certificate should be based on your most recent financial statement. CPA Audited or Reviewed statements are preferred. Contractor Score is a third-party professional tool that measures a contractor's current management and financial capacity. Much like the consumer credit score, the Contractor Score evaluation result indicates a contractor's relative financial and management health. It is applicable to Subcontractors and General Contractors alike. A non-disclosure agreement can be signed by ContractorScore.

Audited Financial Statement

A CPA/third-party prepared financial statement (audited or reviewed) from your last fiscal year-end that includes a dated letter from the CPA firm, balance sheet and statement of income (P&L). A compiled and/or incomplete financial statements will not be accepted. A non-disclosure agreement can be signed by Boldt.

- Current Work in Progress (WIP) Report (see attached sample)
- EMR Letter (Past three years)
- Safety Manual
- W-9 Form (With full legal name, signed and dated within the current calendar year)
